Since its launch in 2019, the course has successfully completed six cycles and has reached out to more than 10,000 learners across the globe.

Additionally, Dr. Tripathi has authored four books, with financial support for two of them coming from the Indian Council of Social Science Research, Government of India, while the other two were published by HP Hamilton, London. He has also successfully executed nine major research projects, securing grants from esteemed institutions such as the University Grants Commission (UGC) for four projects, the Department of Science and Technology for one, and the Indian Council of Social Science Research for four more.

In his international engagements, Dr. Tripathi has been associated with two prestigious projects. The project "The Room Where It Happens" was aimed to impart Media Literacy Skills to Generation Z and was sponsored by the US Department of State. His other project is Erasmus+ CBHE, is funded by European Union.

Dr. Tripathi's academic contributions extend to presenting papers and chairing sessions at over 100 renowned national and international conferences, Faculty Development Programs, and invited lectures. Furthermore, he has published more than 50 scholarly works, including research papers, book chapters, and open education resources (OERs). Some of his publications have found their place in Scopus-indexed journals, Routledge (USA), Transnational Press, London, as well as UGC Care journals.

Dr. Tripathi, as a global citizen, is profoundly committed to promoting equity and accessibility in higher education and ensuring educational opportunities for all. This commitment aligns seamlessly with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goal 4, which advocates for the provision of quality education to everyone.
